









Description

DL-101 course builds on the concepts presented in the Primer on Intellectual Property (DL-001). It provides participants with a more in-depth overview of the fundamentals of intellectual property (IP) law, and is indispensable for the more advanced courses of study on specific areas of IP law.

DL101GE is the first distance learning course about intellectual property which was translated in Georgian and adapted to Georgian legislation by the National Intellectual Property Center of Georgia –SAKPATENTI in cooperation with the WIPO Academy.

DL101GE is open for registration for any interested person.

Content and structure

The course includes 13 modules, at the end of which there is a final exam:

- Module 1: Introduction to IP
- Module 2: Copyright
- Module 3: Related rights
- Module 4: Trademarks
- Module 5: Geographical indications
- Module 6: Industrial designs
- Module 7: Patents
- Module 8: Unfair competition
- Module 9: WIPO treaties
- Module 10: Protection of new varieties of plants
- Module 11: IP and development
- **Module 12:** Introduction to traditional knowledge, traditional cultural expressions and genetic resources
- Module 13: Summary and discussion
- Final Exam

Teaching

Academic support is provided throughout the course; learners can pose substantive questions to tutors online. Self-assessment tools are strategically placed throughout each module to help each participant gauge their level of knowledge and progress, and their ability to apply the concepts and facts presented within the course.

Online discussions and assignments

Using the Academy's enhanced learning platform, experienced tutors/IP experts discuss landmark cases with participants.

Final exam

The final exam for this course includes a series of multiple-choice questions. Participants have a fixed amount of time in which they have to complete and submit the exam online. Participants will receive details on how to access the exam approximately one week before the deadline for completing the course

Certificate

Participants who pass the final exam are awarded an electronic certificate of course completion.

Duration

The course is taught over a period of six weeks. It is estimated that the course material can be reviewed in approximately 60 hours during that six-week period.

Target audience

This course is designed for people who are interested in the field of intellectual property rights (IPRs). It is also relevant for people seeking a general knowledge of IP, and particularly for students, young scholars, lawyers etc.

Language of instruction

The DL-101 course is offered in all six official languages of the United Nations (Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish) as well as in Portuguese. Other language versions such as Bulgarian, Cambodian, Croatian, Georgian, Thai and Vietnamese are offered by different national IP offices. The course was translated and adapted to the Georgian legislation by the National Intellectual Property Center of Georgia – SAKPATENTI in close cooperation with WIPO Academy and DL101GE was made available in Georgian language on the WIPO Academy website, on the WIPO Accounts. The DL-101 is also available in an accessible format for the blind, visually impaired, or otherwise print disabled.
